Students who will register for new students as of the 2025-2026 Academic Year will be able to enroll in all programs in the Faculties of

1. INTRODUCTION OF OPEN EDUCATION FACULTY

Anadolu University is a contemporary, dynamic and innovative state university founded in 1958. With the Decree Law No. 41 issued on July 20, 1982, the task of Continuous and Open Education was given to Anadolu University, which has a scientific and technological infrastructure. In this context, Anadolu University is the first institution in our country to provide open higher education with the principle of equal opportunity and distance education model in the contemporary sense.

Anadolu University Open Education and Distance Education System; Education is carried out based on the credit system. In the Open Education Faculty, students from different age groups and backgrounds can easily access courses and many printed and digital resources online. Anadolu University, which has completed its 43rd year in the higher education system; It is one of the largest universities in the world with more than 1 million students and more than 4 million graduates. In addition, our university is a member of the European Association of Distance Teaching Universities (EADTU), the European University Association (EUA), the Asian Association of Open Universities (AAOU), the International Council for Open and Distance Education (ICDE), the European Distance and E-Learning Network - EDEN), COMSTECH Inter-Islamic Network On Virtual Universities (CINVU), Open Education Global member.

Anadolu University Open Education Faculty provides open and distance education opportunities to students from all over the world. At this point, we share our experience in education with the world through high-quality teaching with the Open Education Faculty. The Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus continues to provide higher education services in Africa, Albania, Azerbaijan, United Arab Emirates, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Indonesia, Iran, Iraq, Montenegro, Kazakhstan, Qatar, Kyrgyzstan, Kosovo, North Macedonia, North America, South America, Lebanon, Egypt, Moldova, Uzbekistan, Romania, Serbia, Saudi Arabia, Oman, Asia Pacific, Jordan and Greece (Western Thrace) and various European countries.

Our university's diplomas are recognized by the Turkish Council of Higher Education (YÖK). 06.11.1982 of the Open Higher Education Regulation published in the Official Gazette dated 17860 and numbered 13. In the article, it is stated that "There is no difference between open education students and formal education students according to the same curriculum in terms of student rights, and those who graduate from both paths have equal rights and authorities." Accordingly, there is no difference between those who graduated from formal and open education programs.

For this reason, since our students enrolled in Anadolu University Open Education Faculty Foreign Programs are responsible for the same content as the higher education given in Turkey, their diplomas of the relevant program are equivalent to the higher education diplomas of formal students in Turkey.

There are higher education programs at the associate degree level (2 years long) consisting of four semesters and at the undergraduate level (4 years) consisting of eight semesters. Each academic year consists of Fall and Spring semesters. Depending on the Academic Calendar prepared by our university, the Fall Semester usually starts in September and the Spring Semester starts in March. The language of instruction of the programs in the Open Education Faculty is Turkish and English.

Students must take at least 120 ECTS (ECTS- European Credit Transfer System) in order to graduate from associate degree programs, at least 240 ECTS credits in order to graduate from undergraduate departments, be successful in all the courses they take, have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 2.00 and fulfill the obligations expected from them.

Education in the Open Education Faculty is carried out based on the credit system. Credit system; courses are determined on a semester basis, an academic year consists of two semesters, fall and spring, a midterm and a final exam are held in each semester, there is no make-up exam, students with summer school must renew their registration on the dates determined at the beginning of each semester in order to continue the course and benefit from student rights, in registration renewal periods, students must not exceed a total of 45 European Credit Transfer System (ECTS) credits. It is an education system in which 10 courses can be added, the courses are credited according to the time they occupy in the program and the effort required, and the compulsory credit amount is completed.

In the credit system, in associate degree programs, the fall semester consists of the 1st and 3rd semesters, the spring semester consists of the 2nd and 4th semesters; In undergraduate programs, fall semester 1st, 3rd, 5th and 7th semesters, spring semester 2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th semesters.

Since the principle of passing courses is applied in the credit system, there is no concept of class. For this reason, students are not divided into 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th grades. Students must take fall semester courses in the fall semester and spring semester courses in the spring semester.

2. REGISTRATION AND REGISTRATION RENEWAL

The student who has the right to enroll in our faculties first registers to the system. In the following periods, the registration is renewed.

4. LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

4.1. ANADOLUM eCampus System

ANADOLUM eCampus System; It is a learning management system that aims to maximize interaction and increase learner motivation by making use of learning and communication technologies.

ANADOLUM eCampus System is a learning management system that offers open and distance learning services in an integrated manner and has a modular structure. Students can work by accessing the learning support materials prepared for their courses from eCampus. Although there may be differences between courses in terms of the type and number of materials, the learning materials offered to students include textbooks, unit summaries, let's learn with questions, unit lecture videos, simultaneous lectures, unit practice questions, practice exams, infographics, interactive content, exam questions from previous semesters (if the course is not taught for the first time in the relevant semester) and live course recordings.

ANADOLUM eCampus System consists of the following components:

- Learning Management System (LMS)
- Tracking Learner Analytics
- Live Lesson Platform
- Mobile Application (Anadolu Mobile)

Anadolu University Study Platform ANADOLUM eCampus System ekampus.anadolu.edu.tr can be accessed by logging in with their TR ID/student numbers and passwords.

4.2. Textbooks

Textbooks, which are effective and efficient material for student self-learning and have been used as basic teaching materials since their inception, are prepared by a team of experts with a very strong technical infrastructure.

Textbooks are available to students in digital (PDF) format. Students are responsible for the content in the current version (PDF) of the textbook presented in the eCampus environment during the exams. Other course materials offered in the eCampus environment (Unit Summary, Let's Learn with Questions, Unit Summary Videos, Leaf Test, etc.) are content that aids learning. Students can access these contents by ekampus.anadolu.edu.tr address by logging in with their TR ID/student numbers and passwords.

In some courses in the Student's Program, e-learning materials may be offered instead of books. Students will be responsible for these contents offered on the eCampus during the course and exam. Printed or electronic books may not be available for each course.

5. MEASUREMENT AND EVALUATION

Students enrolled in the Open Education Faculty take two exams for each course, one midterm exam and one final exam in each semester, in the fall and spring semesters.

Students will take midterm and final exams for the courses they are enrolled in in the 2025-2026 academic year on the dates specified below.

Students who cannot attend the midterm exam can take the final exam. In the exam entry document of the students; The course to take the exam, exam center, building, hall, date and time information are included.

Students can get the Exam Entry Document from their aof.anadolu.edu.tr [address Student Information System one week before the exam date](#) by logging in with their TR ID/student numbers and passwords. Exam Entry Documents are not sent to students' addresses by mail.

Students must take the exam at the exam center, building, hall, desk, date and time written on the Exam Entry Document. Students must see the building where they will take the exam at least one day before the exam and must be present in the building where they will take the exam one hour before the exam time. For students who do not take the exam at the place and date specified in the Exam Entry Document, no make-up exam will be held at another place or time. It is not possible to reserve the right to take the exam for any reason.

5.1. Documents Required to Take the Exam

- Exam Entry Document with Photo,
- Photo and Approved Identity Document.

In order to take the exam, you must present the Exam Entry Document and the Identity Document with Photo and Approval (identity card with photo, cold stamp and TR ID number/Republic of Turkey ID card/Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus ID card, driver's license with TR ID number, valid passport, Blue Card belonging to those who have left Turkish citizenship with permission and their legal heirs, with a photo issued by the General Directorate of Population and Citizenship Affairs, signed, sealed and valid Temporary Identity Document can be used for this purpose). Documents other than these (professional identity cards, etc.) are not accepted as valid identity documents for entering the exam. Document checks will be made by the relevant examiners and those with missing documents will not be admitted to the exam.

If even one of these two documents required for the exam is missing, the student will not be allowed to take the exam.

5.2. Rules to be Applied in the Exam

- After the first 15 minutes of the exam, no student is allowed to enter the exam building for any reason. You cannot leave the hall within the first 30 minutes and the last 5 minutes of the exam, even if you complete your exam. If you leave the hall for any reason, you are

not allowed to continue the exam.

- A calculator can be used in the exam. However, the machine used must be a simple non-functional calculator that can perform only four operations.

- Paper, books, notebooks, notes, etc. documents; compasses, protractors, rulers, etc. tools; communication, storage, recording and data transfer devices such as mobile phones, computers, tablets, radios, cameras, etc.; Even if it is licensed or for official purposes, it is strictly forbidden to take the exam with weapons and objects that can replace weapons.
- It is forbidden to talk to the officials, ask questions, and talk to the students closely and softly during the exam. If necessary, the staff can change the student's location
- While evaluating the exam, the score is calculated by deducting a quarter of the number of wrong answers from the number of correct answers in each test.
- Check the TR ID number, name-surname, information on the answer sheet given to you, fill in the relevant fields on it and sign it. If this information does not belong to you, warn the staff and ask for your answer sheet. The exams of students who use an answer sheet belonging to another student are considered invalid in that session.
- The exams of students who do not code the test group (booklet type) on the answer sheet or who code more than once are considered invalid.
- You should use a bold black pencil for all kinds of writing and marking on your answer sheet. The exams of students who use a different pen (ballpoint, ink or colored, etc.) other than black pencil are considered invalid.
- In the following cases, an Individual Exam Cancellation Report is prepared by the examiners and the exams of the relevant students in that session are deemed invalid;
- Not complying with the exam rules and the warnings of the examiners, disrupting the exam order,
- To keep "objects that are prohibited to be brought to the exam" with them,
- Sharing pencils, erasers, tools and equipment with other students during the exam,
- Writing the answers somewhere other than the answer sheet and taking them out of the exam hall or attempting to take them out,
- Unless otherwise stated, to take the exam in official dress (except for privates and conscripts on leave from their continents),
- To participate in the exam and mark on the answer sheet even though the documents required to take the exam are missing,
- Not delivering the answer sheet and/or question booklet to the examiners completely and intact, taking them out of the exam hall,
- Cheating, cheating, or assisting in cheating or attempting to cheat, etc.,
- Damaging exam documents,
- To take the exam on behalf of someone else or to take the exam on behalf of another student,
- To read the exam questions and/or mark the answers in person, even though he/she receives reader and/or marker support upon request,
- To keep any text, formula, drawing on the exam entry document, on any item or on it, whether it helps to solve the exam questions or not.

- The student must leave the Exam Entry Document and Photo and Approved Identity Document on the desk before the exam starts

- The time given for each lesson in the question booklet is 30 minutes.
- When the question booklet is received, it should be quickly checked whether there are any incorrect or missing prints on the pages. In case of error/incompleteness, the Hall President should be applied to change the booklet. The booklet should not be reopened until the examiners indicate that the exam has started.
- The student must fill in and sign the name-surname, TR ID number, exam hall number, queue number information in the relevant fields in the question booklet. The empty spaces in the question booklet can be used for draft purposes.
- The student should compare the booklet code specified on the answer sheet with the code of the question booklet, and if it is not the same, inform the examiners and request that the correct booklet be given.
- The student should mark his/her answers in the area reserved for the relevant course on the answer sheet, without going beyond the answer place. Markings made on the question booklet will not be evaluated.
- When the student wants to make changes on the answer sheet, he/she should use a non-marking eraser. The answer sheet should not be crumpled, folded or placed on it without any unnecessary marks.
- In multiple-choice questions, each question has only one correct answer, when multiple options are selected for a question, that question will be considered as a wrong answer.
- The contents of the courses to which the questions belong may have been changed after publication. In this case, the answer to the question should be answered by taking into account the information given in the textbook.
- At the end of the exam, the answer sheet and question booklet must be delivered to the hall staff in full. Answer sheets sent after the exam is over will not be taken into consideration.

5.3. Publication of Exam Questions and Answers and Exam Results on the Internet and Objection Process

Students can access the exam questions and answers of the relevant semester [by logging in with their TR ID/student numbers and passwords from](#) Anadolu Mobile and ekampus.anadolu.edu.tr addresses.

Students aof.anadolu.edu the exam questions within 2 (two) working days from the date of announcement. tr address Student Information System section. Objections made after this period are not taken into consideration. The results of the objections are published on the same page.

5.4. Evaluation of Exams and Course Passing

Evaluation of exams and course passing system; It is determined according to the "[Anadolu University Open Education Faculty Education and Examination Regulations](#)" and the "[Anadolu University Open Education Faculty Education and Examination Application Procedures and Principles](#)" and "[Anadolu University Open Education Faculty Student Evaluation System Principles](#)"_prepared based on the authority granted by this Regulation.

Two types of documents are used in the exams: question booklet and answer sheet. On the answer sheet, be sure to code the column reserved for the relevant course and clearly written the name of the course. Markings made to the wrong column are not evaluated at all.

Depending on the number of students, one (A), two (A, B) or four (A, B, C, D) booklet types can be used in the exams.



In the exams, the test group must be coded with a pencil on the answer sheet.

A midterm and final exam are held for each course in a semester. Exams; supervised face-to-face and/or online; It may include different types of questions such as multiple choice, open-ended, short answer, true-false and matching. However, according to the nature of the course, the midterm exam; It can also be done with written, oral, homework, practice, project and similar measurement and evaluation tools. In courses such as projects with only final exams, partial exams are applied. A final exam grade is created by combining the partial exams and the contribution of this grade to the success grade is 100%.

The dates and application principles of midterm and final exams are determined by the relevant faculty administrative board and announced together with the academic calendar at the beginning of the academic year.

Information processing methods are used in the evaluation of exams, recording grades, recording them in charts, storing them, writing them in student registers and announcing them to students. Students can object to the exam results within 2 (two) working days from the date of announcement [by logging in with their TR ID/student numbers and passwords](#) from the Student Information System section of their aof.anadolu.edu.tr address. Objections made after this period are not taken into consideration. The results of the objections are published on the same page.

5.5. Exams of Detained and Convicted Students

If detained and convicted students want to take the exam in the Prison and Detention House, they must apply to the prison directorates one month before each exam period (considering the possibility of release). The Ministry of Justice notifies the list of students who will take the exam through the channel determined by the University between the dates determined by Anadolu University, and students who are not included in this list and students who are transferred to a different Prison and Detention Center after being informed are not allowed to take the exam in the Prison and Detention House to which they are transferred.

Apart from this, applications made directly to Anadolu University by students, prison directorates and relevant prosecutor's offices are not processed.

Students enrolled in the Abroad Programs are informed about the education process and exams [from](#) the "Announcements" section of the globalcampus.anadolu.edu.tr address and to the e-mail addresses registered in the system (aosogrenci.anadolu.edu.tr). In order for our communication with you to continue uninterrupted, you should check your e-mail address

from the "Information Update", "Contact" option in the student information system (aosogrenci.anadolu.edu.tr) menu and update it as soon as possible if there is a change. Students should check their globalcampus.anadolu.edu.tr address and email daily.

It is explained below which service students can get and where.

6.1. Student ID Card

The Student ID Cards of active students enrolled in the Open Education Faculty have been digitized in a verifiable way with a QR code. Students can access their Digital IDs by clicking on the "Digital ID Viewing" field on the Student Information System page or Anadolu Mobile application. Student ID Card is not physically printed.

6.2. Student Certificate

Students can request a Student Certificate via e-Government or by applying to AÖF Registration Centers in person or by mail. Students who exceed the maximum education period can obtain an Education Status Certificate instead of a student certificate.

6.3. Military Service Deferment Procedures

In the letter of the Ministry of National Defense dated 10/08/2018 and numbered 375580-18 sent to our university; "As of August 27, 2018, the practice of issuing and sending "Student Certificates", which includes information about those newly enrolled in higher education and graduated/dropout obliged persons and sent to military branches, has been terminated."

Accordingly, the information of the students who have newly registered to our Faculty with the Republic of Turkey ID number, those who have been deregistered and the graduates are sent to the Ministry of National Defense electronically via YÖKSİS via web services.

Military branches impose fines on students who do not apply on time even though they are of age. Anadolu University will not be responsible for any grievances that may arise.

Article 20 (2) of the Military Recruitment Law No. 7179. In the article; It is stated that "Obligated persons ..., for those studying in faculties, colleges and vocational schools, provided that it does not exceed the end of the year in which they complete the age of 28, until they graduate or are dismissed." In this context; A postponement request will be sent to students enrolled in the Open Education Faculty until the end of the year in which they complete the age of 28, and no postponement request will be sent to students who have reached the age of 28.

Students enrolled within the scope of the Second University cannot benefit from military service deferment procedures. Students enrolled in the Second University who want to cancel their registration in formal education and have their deferment procedures carried out by our Faculty will submit the document and petition showing that their registration in formal education has been canceled to the AÖF Foreign Programs Unit or Nicosia Registration Center.

Male students enrolled in the Open Education Faculty are required to follow their military service deferment status from the Student Information System or e-government at aof.anadolu.edu.tr address.

6.4. Approval of Student Documents and Other Documents Requested by Foreign Countries

Our students obtain some rights from the insurance and similar institutions of the countries they live in due to their higher education. The forms sent from abroad to be used and approved in obtaining these rights or requested by the Social Security Institution for this purpose are filled in and approved by our faculty. For this reason, the education certificate from abroad must be sent to our faculty by mail or via AOSDESTTEK, together with the petition, in order to be approved.

6.5. Personal Information and Test Center Changes

Students; address, e-mail address, phone number, job-profession and population information and exam center changes can be made from the aof.anadolu.edu.tr address Student Information System link.

If the exam center change is made after the exam organization starts, it will be valid for the next exams. For this reason, students should consider the dates and explanations given below when changing the exam center.

6.6. Registration Deletion

Students who want to cancel their registration can delete their registration by logging in with their e-government password from the Registration Deletion tab under the Registration Information menu from the Student Information System link of their aof.anadolu.edu.tr address, or they must apply to the AÖF Registration Center or the Overseas Programs Unit with their identity document, or if they cannot apply, their representative must apply with a power of attorney.

Students who owe semester teaching material fees and student contribution fees from previous academic years must pay these debts to the bank before canceling their registration.

Since the deregistration process is notified to the student, YÖKSİS, the relevant military branch, and Anadolu University automation system at the same time and it is not possible to cancel this process, our students should not apply without making their final decision on deregistration. The amounts paid for the program for which the registration is canceled are not refunded.

A student who is currently enrolled in a program at the Open Education Faculty must cancel their old registration in order to enroll in a new program in the 2024-2025 academic year.



In accordance with the provision of the Law on the Amendment of the Higher Education Law and Certain Laws, published in the Official Gazette dated April 17, 2020 and numbered 31102, "Students who do not fulfill the registration renewal conditions for four consecutive semesters in the open education system will be dismissed from the relevant program.", the registration of students enrolled in the associate/undergraduate programs of Anadolu University Open Education Faculty and who do not renew their registration for 4 consecutive semesters will be deleted.

6.7. Graduation and Post-Graduation Procedures

A student who has taken at least 120 ECTS credits in the associate degree program and at least 240 ECTS credits in the undergraduate program, successfully completed all courses, has a GPA of at least 2.00, does not have FF, YZ and DZ grades and fulfills other obligations, is awarded a bachelor's or associate degree diploma of the program he/she is enrolled in.

6.8. Diploma

Digital Diplomas are issued to graduates starting from the Spring Semester of the 2022-2023 Academic Year. After the graduations are reflected in the system, our graduates can view their Digital Diploma from the Student Information System and get a transcript in PDF format. All information on the diploma is displayed on the verification screen by scanning the QR code on the front of the Digital Diplomas. Students who are obliged to do internship can receive their Digital Diplomas from the Student Information System after documenting that they have completed their internship. Printed diplomas will not be issued to those who graduate in the Spring Semester of the 2022-2023 Academic Year and after.

The digital diplomas of graduates who owe semester tuition expenses and semester tuition fees/semester student contributions will be issued after paying their debts.

Graduates who graduated before the Spring Semester of the 2022-2023 Academic Year and have not yet received their printed diplomas can apply to the AÖF Nicosia Office with their special IDs (such as identity card, driver's license with TR ID number, passport) by themselves or through their legal representatives and receive it in return for signature. Diplomas are not delivered to people other than these.

Temporary Graduation Certificate is not issued to our graduates other than diplomas.

Diplomas of graduates who owe semester teaching material fees are not given unless they pay their debts.

Our graduates must check the accuracy of the information on their diploma before receiving it.

After the graduation date; Due to the change in identity information, no retrospective correction is made in the diploma, except for legal obligations and gender changes.

6.9. Diploma Equivalence of Programs Abroad

Anadolu University Open Education Faculty diplomas are equivalent to the diplomas of other faculties providing formal education in the same field in Turkey. It can be notified to all domestic or foreign public and private institutions that these diplomas can benefit from the rights provided by diplomas given at the undergraduate or associate degree level according to the laws of the Republic of Turkey.

6.10. Obtaining an Associate Degree Diploma from the Undergraduate Program

Undergraduate program students;

- Successful by taking at least 120 ECTS credits in the first four semesters,
- Pursuant to subparagraph (i) of the first paragraph of Article 5 of the Law No. 2547, those who have taken and succeeded in the compulsory courses Atatürk's Principles and History of Revolution I-II, Turkish Language I-II and Foreign Language I-II,
- Without FF, YZ, HA and DZ grades,
- Have a GPA of at least 2.00,
- Those who fulfill their other obligations,

Provided that the student cancels his/her registration from the Information System, he/she can view the Digital Associate Degree Diploma and take a transcript in PDF format.

In accordance with the decision of the Council of Higher Education, the field is not specified in the diplomas of those who have canceled their registration from the undergraduate program

and received an associate degree.

6.11. Diploma Supplement

It is an international document that aims to provide detailed information about the degree, content and function of the degree held by the graduate. This document also contains information describing the national education system.

If graduates of 2010 and later [apply](#) with a signed petition to globalcampus@anadolu.edu.tr e-mail address, a "Diploma Supplement" is issued. In case of loss or unusability of the "Diploma Supplement", a new one is issued upon the request of the graduate, and an English Grade Status Certificate is issued for those who graduated before 2010. The Diploma Supplement cannot be used instead of a diploma; however, it is valid together with the diploma.

6.12. Issuance of Second Copy Diploma (Duplicate Copy)

In case the diploma is lost or becomes unusable, a new diploma is issued to the graduates, provided that the information in the previous diploma is included. On the front of this diploma, there is the phrase Second Copy (Duplicate Copy).



Since the Digital Diploma is issued to those who graduate from the Spring Semester of the 2022-2023 Academic Year, a "Second Copy Diploma" is not given.

Graduates who request a Second Copy Diploma can apply in person or via AOSDESTTEK by paying the diploma fee of ₺200.00 and attaching the original receipt they received from the bank to their petitions. The second copy of the diploma issued can be received with a special identity document (such as identity card, driver's license with TR ID number, passport) from the AÖF Nicosia Office in return for signature by themselves or through their legal representatives.

If the lost diploma is found or the request for a Second Copy Diploma is abandoned, the amount deposited in the bank will not be refunded.

6.13. Transcript

The Transcript is a document that shows the success of the students in the courses they have taken during their education at the faculty. Students can obtain a Transcript of Grade Status by applying to the AÖF Registration Center or Central Office via e-Government.

6.14. Course Descriptions

Students and graduates enrolled in the Open Education Faculty can get the course contents of the courses they have taken by applying to the AÖF Nicosia Registration Center or the AÖF International Programs Unit.

6.15. Honor and High Honor Certificate

From registered students; Those who have taken at least 30 ECTS credits and are successful in all the courses they have taken, and whose semester grade point average is 3.50 or above are considered High Honor Students, and those whose grade point average is between 3.00 and 3.49 are considered Honor Students. However, students who receive disciplinary action or have grades of FF, YZ, and DZ are not considered High Honor Students or Honor Students, even if they achieve the specified grade point averages.

Those with a GPA of 3.50 or above graduate as High Honor Students, and those with a GPA between 3.00 and 3.49 graduate as Honor Students. However, students who receive disciplinary punishment cannot graduate as High Honor Students or Honor Students, even if they achieve the specified GPA.

Honor/High Honor Certificates are uploaded as PDF to the student page of deserving students.

6.16. Transplant

Students who move to the country where the Abroad Programs are located or to Turkey are transferred so that they can continue their education in the department they are enrolled in. Every year in July-August; Students of Abroad (Cyprus) Programs or students who will request transfer to these programs can apply by e-mail to globalcampus@anadolu.edu.tr address. Applications are examined and the transfer of students who meet the necessary conditions is made for the next academic year. The transferred student pays the fee of the program to which he/she is transferred.

7. EDUCATION RIGHTS

7.1. Duration of Education

The student can benefit from the right to be a student for four years (eight semesters) for associate degree and seven years (fourteen semesters) for bachelor's degree, starting from the semester in which he/she is registered. The student cannot benefit from the right to be a student and cannot participate in the exams during the periods when he/she does not renew his/her registration. The periods in which the student does not renew their registration are counted as the maximum education period. Those who exceed the maximum education period cannot receive student service except for exams.

Pursuant to the provisional Article 67 added to the Law No. 2547 by the Law No. 6569 published in the Official Gazette dated November 26, 2014 and numbered 29187, the maximum education period of the students has been restarted as of the Fall Semester of the 2014-2015 Academic Year. This application covers students who registered before the 2014-2015 academic year.

The Law on the Amendment of the Higher Education Law and Certain Laws, published in the Official Gazette dated April 17, 2020 and numbered 31102, includes the provision that "Students who do not fulfill the registration renewal conditions for four consecutive semesters in the open education system are dismissed from the relevant program." Accordingly, it has become a legal obligation to delete the registration of students who do not renew their registration for 4 consecutive semesters. Students who do not want to continue their education and lose their registration rights must renew their registration in this process.

7.2. Compulsory Attendance to Classes

Although there is no compulsory attendance in the Open Education Faculty Abroad Programs, there are departments that require internship. www.anadolu.edu information about internship in the relevant programs. [tr/acikogretim](http://tr.acikogretim) can be accessed by selecting Faculty and Program from the Turkey Programs link.

7.3. Exemption

Course transfer and exemption procedures [are carried out according to the "Anadolu University Open Education Faculty Course Transfer and Exemption Principles"](#). Detailed information can be found on the relevant registration dates at globalcampus.anadolu.edu.tr address is announced separately in the Announcements section.

7.4. Programs with Internship and Practice Courses

Courses affiliated to the Internship and Practice Courses Coordinatorship; It is structured in two separate categories as Internship Courses (Table 1) and Practice Courses (Table 2). The operation and processes of the courses vary. The attendance, evaluation method and activity periods of the courses in these programs are explained under the relevant headings.

7.4.1. Internship Courses

The attendance, evaluation method and activity periods of the internship carried out under the Internship and Practice Courses Coordinatorship are given in Table 1.

academic years. Students who register in the following semesters do not have an internship application.

Internship courses in Tourism and Travel Services, Electrical Energy Generation, Transmission and Distribution, Medical Laboratory Techniques, Pharmacy Services, Food Quality Control and Analysis, Nursing and Midwifery Associate Degree Programs, which have been suspended, are carried out on an assignment-based basis through the Learning Management System (e-portfolio). Students enrolled in these programs are obliged to prepare the assignments determined by the relevant program coordinator and upload them to the e-portfolio system on the dates specified in the Student Internship Guide.

Internship courses will be automatically assigned to students who register for the first time as of the 2025-2026 academic year, together with the first semester courses. However, students will be able to take the compulsory internship course after the 2nd semester final exam. When the internship course assignment is made, it will be displayed in the Student Information System with the letter grade HA (Not Yet Taken). The letter grade of the students who successfully complete the homework evaluation process will be updated to YT (Satisfactory). The internship course success status of the students registered in the system will also be arranged according to the letter grade of YT (Satisfactory) or HA (Not Yet Taken).

Since students enrolled in the Electrical Energy Generation, Transmission and Distribution Associate Degree Program in 2011-2012 and previous academic years do not have an internship requirement, these students cannot take internship courses. In the Geographic Information Systems Associate Degree Program (Distance Education), there is no internship obligation for students enrolled in the 2016-2017 academic year and later.

Since students enrolled in the Social Services Associate Degree Program in 2010-2011 and previous academic years and students enrolled in the 2015-2016 academic year do not have an internship requirement, these students are not obliged to do internship. Internship is optional for students enrolled between the 2011-2012 academic year and the 2014-2015 academic year. The student can take the optional internship course after the 2nd semester final exam.

In the Emergency and Disaster Management Associate Degree Program, students must do their compulsory internship at once in any semester after the 2nd semester final exam, the compulsory internship is not divided into different time periods. Students can complete their internships in the fields of "Ministry of Interior", "Ministry of Health", "Ministry of Environment, Urbanization and Climate Change", "Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure", "Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry", "Ministry of Interior - AFAD", "Red Crescent", "Municipalities", emergency, disaster management, search and rescue, health services in emergencies, security in disaster areas, security services in emergency events, urban planning and urban transformation, disaster and emergency coordination, disaster and emergency response, They will be able to do it in workplaces with fields of activity such as safe urbanization.

In the Disabled Care and Rehabilitation Associate Degree Program, students must do their compulsory internship at once in any semester after the 2nd semester final exam. Internship cannot be divided and done in different time periods. Students can do their internship in Disabled Care and Rehabilitation Centers, Elderly Care and Rehabilitation Centers, Hospitals for Spastic Children, Nursing Homes, Disabled Care Centers and Elderly Care Centers affiliated to the Ministry of Family and Social Services. In addition, students can do internships in Special Care Centers supervised by the Ministry of Family and Social Services. The specified internship places must be organizations or centers that provide boarding services. If there is no quota in the specified institutions, students can also do internship in Special Education and Rehabilitation Centers affiliated to the Ministry of National Education.

The student's internship attendance is followed by the managers (institution manager or deputy

director) in that organization. During the internship, the internship performance of the student is monitored by the professional personnel (any of those with the title of physician, social worker, psychologist, psychological counselor, child development specialist, physiotherapist, occupational therapist and nurse) in that institution.

Students enrolled in the Laboratory and Veterinary Health Associate Degree Program in the 2011-2012 academic year and the following academic years must do their compulsory internship at once in any semester after the 2nd semester final exam. Internship cannot be divided and done in different time periods. Since there is no internship requirement for students enrolled in 2010-2011 and previous academic years, these students cannot do internship.

Students do their internship; State Hospitals, Faculties of Medicine, Training and Research Hospitals affiliated to the Ministry of Health (clinical biochemistry, clinical microbiology, pathology, blood bank and hematology laboratories, other laboratories performing virological, toxicology, biochemical tests and analysis), Public Health Laboratory (Hematology Unit), relevant units affiliated to the Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry (Veterinary Control Institute Directorates, Provincial and District Agriculture and Forestry Directorates Laboratories), Regional Laboratories, Department Laboratories of Veterinary Faculties, Public-Private Food Control Laboratories, Private Veterinary Clinics and Private Veterinary Hospitals, Private Veterinary Pathology Laboratories, Veterinary Pharmaceutical Companies, Public-Private Livestock and Livestock-Based Industrial Enterprises, Companies Operating in the Food Sector, Feed Factories.

In the Tourism and Hotel Management Associate Degree Program, the student must do his compulsory internship at once in any semester after the 2nd semester final exam. Internship cannot be divided and done in different time periods. The student can do his compulsory internship in hotels, holiday village businesses, travel agencies and universities with a Tourism Management or Tourism Investment Certificate; guesthouses, guesthouses or practice hotels of Tourism Vocational Schools. In addition, airline companies and airport operators, congress and fair organization company companies, theme parks and entertainment centers, tourism departments of municipalities are also considered suitable for internships.

In the Tourism Management (Accommodation Management) Undergraduate Program, the student must do his/her optional internship at once in any semester after the 2nd semester final exam. Internship cannot be divided and done in different time periods. The student can do his internship in hotels, holiday village businesses and public institutions approved by the internship commission that have a Tourism Management or Tourism Investment Certificate.



Students who want to do internship voluntarily in programs that do not have an internship obligation are not given a letter stating that they can do an internship.

Internship exemption

According to the Internship Directive Accepted by the Decision of the Anadolu University Senate dated 19.03.2021 and numbered 8/1;

Article 14. (1) In programs with compulsory internship, students who officially document the following situations may be exempted from internship by the decision of the Faculty Administrative Board:

The student must have worked in the sector, relevant unit and profession related to the program he/she is enrolled in, as an insured subject to SSI, for at least the compulsory internship period.

The student must have done an internship in another higher education institution for the compulsory internship period related to the professional field of the program he/she is enrolled in.

Convicted/detained and disabled students who enrolled in the program before 2021 and whose right to be a student continues, must certify that they are permanently disabled and that the disability rate is 40% or above with a Health Board Report to be obtained from a full-fledged hospital for programs in Turkey and from a hospital in their country for programs abroad.

Convicted/detained students who enrolled in the program before 2021 and whose right to be a student continues, the time they will spend in prison/detention center from the date of registration to the program must be more than 4 years in associate degree programs.

(2) Students who are registered in the country and request exemption must submit all kinds of documents they will provide (cover letter showing that they work in the relevant sector and relevant unit, SSI service statement, transcript, transcript, transcript, document showing that they have done an internship before, time limit, health report, etc.) Uploads it to the Student Information System with the Exemption Form and submits it to the Internship and Practice Courses Coordinatorship. The field coordinator or assistant coordinator of the relevant program completes the exemption procedures within the date ranges specified in the Internship Evaluation Calendar for the relevant academic year. The internship exemption form must be filled in computer environment and without spoiling its format.

(3) Students who are registered abroad and request exemption must upload the sworn Turkish translation of all kinds of documents they will provide to the Student Information System with a petition and submit it to the Internship and Practice Courses Coordinatorship, if they document the above-mentioned situations.

7.4.2. Practice Courses

There are practice courses in a total of 10 programs affiliated to the Internship and Practice Courses Coordinatorship. The attendance, evaluation method and activity periods of the application course in these programs are given in Table 2.

The application courses in the Social Work Undergraduate Program, Electrical Energy Generation, Transmission and Distribution Associate Degree Program, which has been suspended, are carried out on an assignment-based basis through the Learning Management System (e-portfolio). Students enrolled in these programs are obliged to prepare the assignments determined by the relevant program coordinator and academic advisors and upload them to the e-portfolio system.

In addition to the homework evaluation system carried out through the e-portfolio in the Preschool Teaching Undergraduate Program and English Language Teaching Undergraduate Program, students have to practice in the field for 12 weeks.

Students who do not complete their homework in Electrical Energy Generation, Transmission and Distribution, Pharmacy Services, Food Quality Control and Analysis, Chemical Technology, Medical Laboratory Techniques, Medicinal and Aromatic Plants Associate Degree Programs are considered unsuccessful in the course(s) and evaluated with a letter grade of FF. In these programs, the lower limit value of the "success grade" of the application courses is 60 and the letter grade is CC. Students who get a success grade below 60 are given a direct FF grade. There is no exemption from compulsory laboratory courses.

In the Preschool Teaching Undergraduate Program, there are School Experience courses in the 5th semester, Teaching Practice I in the 7th semester, Teaching Practice II and Community Service Practices in the 8th semester. Practice courses are courses that require attendance. In the Preschool Teaching Undergraduate Program, students practice in preschool education institutions affiliated to the Ministry of National Education in their provinces for 12 weeks for each application course, except for Community Service Practices. Students who do not attend the application courses or do not complete the applications are considered unsuccessful in the courses and are given a letter grade of DZ. The applications are not within the scope of internship. For this course, the student does not have the right to exemption and additional course exams.

In the English Language Teaching Undergraduate Program, there are Community Service Practices I in the 5th semester, Community Service Practices II in the 6th semester, School Experience in the 7th semester and Teaching Practice courses in the 8th semester. Practice courses are courses that require attendance. In the English Language Teaching Undergraduate Program, students practice in secondary education institutions affiliated to the Ministry of National Education in their provinces for 12 weeks for each practice course, except for Community Service Practices I and Community Service Practices II. Students who do not attend the application courses or do not complete the applications are considered unsuccessful in the courses and are given a letter grade of DZ. The applications are not within the scope of internship. For this course, the student does not have the right to exemption and additional course exams.

The "Institutional Practices" course in the 4th semester of the Child Development Associate Degree Program is a compulsory course in which two different evaluation systems are applied: test and homework. In the Institutional Practices course, students are responsible for a multiple-choice midterm exam and a final exam based on the textbook. In addition, students are expected to upload the assignments they have prepared during the semester to the e-portfolio system. Students who do not complete their homework even if they have taken the exam of the theoretical part of the course are considered unsuccessful in the course and evaluated with a letter grade of FF. For this course, the student does not have the right to exemption and additional course exams.

The Social Work Undergraduate Program has Social Work Practice I in the 7th semester and Social Work Practice II in the 8th semester. Students are obliged to upload the assignments they have

prepared for 12 weeks to the e-portfolio system. The applications are not within the scope of internship. For this course, the student does not have the right to exemption and additional course exams.

7.5. Second University

Those who have graduated from any higher education institution and students who are currently enrolled in formal/distance education higher education programs other than Anadolu University Open Education Faculty can apply to the undergraduate or associate degree programs of the Open Education Faculty, those who have undergraduate education, and those who receive associate degree education can apply to associate degree programs within the scope of the Second University without examination, if they wish. Detailed information about the Second University ikinciuniversite.anadolu.edu.tr or globalcampus.anadolu.edu.tr .

7.6. Services Provided to Students with Disabilities

Student candidates with a disability rate of 40% or more must document this situation with a Health Board Report obtained from a full-fledged hospital in Turkey. Disabled students enrolled in the Open Education Faculty can benefit from the following services if they apply.

- In the acquisition, validity, evaluation of the Disability Health Board Report (ESKR/ÇÖZGER) and the determination of the authorized health institutions and organizations that can issue this report; The Regulation on Disability Assessment for Adults and the Regulation on Special Needs Assessment for Children published in the Official Gazette dated 20.02.2019 and numbered 30692 are taken into consideration.
- The status of disabled students who will benefit from the relevant practices in the exams for passing courses in their programs at the Open Education Faculty; It is evaluated within the framework of the Regulation on Health Conditions to be Sought in Examination Practices for Persons with Disabilities and Disabled Quotas published in the Official Gazette dated 08.03.2022 and numbered 31772.
- In accordance with the Anadolu University Board of Directors Decision dated 03.01.2019 and numbered 1/27, students with a disability rate of 40% or more are not charged the Semester Teaching Material Fee.
- According to the Presidential Decree published in the Official Gazette dated 09.07.2025 and numbered 32951, students with Temporary/Permanent Disability additional feature information will not be charged Semester Student Tuition Fee, regardless of the duration of the program.
- Students with visual impairment/disability are provided with reader and marker support in the exams, and these students may be exempted from some questions.
- Students who have visual impairment/disability and are able to read the large-print question booklets are taken to the exam with a large-print booklet if they apply to the AÖF Registration Center or the Open Education Faculty Foreign Programs Unit by making a request through AOSDESTTEK with their reports.
- Students who have a disability/health problem after the last change date of the exam center has passed, if they apply to the AÖF Nicosia Registration Center or the Open Education Faculty Foreign Programs Unit, by making a request through AOSDESTTEK, their reports will be evaluated by the authorities and they will be taken to the exam as deemed appropriate.
- Students who have health problems close to the exam (broken hand or foot, pregnant, surgery, etc.) are taken to the exam according to their situation if they apply to the AÖF Nicosia Registration Center or the Open Education Faculty Foreign Programs Unit by making a request through AOSDESTTEK with their reports.

- Students who use devices, supplementary food, medication for health reasons or who need to go to the toilet during the exam are taken to the exam according to their situation if they apply to the AÖF Nicosia Registration Center or the Open Education Faculty Foreign Programs Unit by making a request through AOSDESTTEK with their reports.

8. PASSWORD AND E-MAIL SERVICES

Every student who enrolls in the Open Education Faculty is given a password after registration. In addition, students registered with their TR ID / student numbers can also use their e-Government passwords.

Students who want to log in with their Anadolu University Account password; www.anadolu.edu.tr/ can get a password from the "Password Transactions" link of the [acikoögretim](http://www.anadolu.edu.tr/) address.

The password is personal and the responsibility that may arise if it is shared with other parties belongs to the student.

Anadolu University e-mail services (<http://www.anadolu.edu.tr/e-posta/islemeler>) can be used by Open Education Faculty students who are still studying. Your password is private to you and you are responsible if you give it to other parties.

9. STUDENT DISCIPLINARY AFFAIRS

Disciplinary affairs of students are carried out in accordance with Article 54 of the Higher Education Law No. 2547 and the Higher Education Institutions Student Disciplinary Regulation. Necessary disciplinary investigations are initiated against those who behave unbecoming of students, those who prevent education and training at the AÖF Nicosia Office, in meetings with the AOSDESTTEK Communication and Solution Desk, in meetings with the Open Education Faculty Foreign Programs Unit, in centers where face-to-face education services are provided, at the exam site or during registration, registration renewal periods and other times, and the provisions of the relevant regulation are applied.

There is no difference between the disciplinary affairs of the students of our faculty and the disciplinary affairs of the students in formal education and the issues they must comply with. This application is also valid for students enrolled in Abroad Programs. Therefore, students enrolled in these programs are not students of Foreign Programs, but of Anadolu University of the Republic of Turkey. Students cannot object on the grounds of local legislation in the country they live in.

Our students should not forget that they are students both in places related to the University and Faculty and in their relations with each other.

In all kinds of written and verbal applications to your faculty and related units, follow the procedure and spelling rules, etiquette and courtesy rules. Otherwise, your applications will not be answered.

10. PASS TRANSACTIONS

Granting a pass for students in Turkey enrolled in Abroad Programs requires a separate organization in each province according to the rules of the relevant municipalities on this subject. Students who will receive a pass can get information about the procedures they need to do from the municipalities in their provinces.

11. APPLICATIONS REGARDING THE RIGHT TO INFORMATION LAW

In order to respond to the applications to be made in accordance with the Right to Information Law No. 4982 without delay and on time, applications must be made to AÖF Nicosia Registration Center and Foreign Programs Unit.
